



Stationery Requirements

A list of stationery requirements is shown below. The school provides the majority of stationery but other suggested items are itemised as appropriate to each year group. School Diaries are required each year by all children, these diaries act as an important means of communication between staff and parents. The school purchases diaries which are handed out at the beginning of the school year.

Please ensure that your son/daughter has the following equipment available in school every day, *clearly labelled*. A great deal of time is wasted during lessons whilst pupils borrow/look for/make excuses for not having the equipment in school. We do our very best to ensure that clearly labelled equipment is returned to its rightful owner if it goes astray. **Please can you refer to this list every half term to see if things need 'topping up'.** Trying to encourage the older pupils to be more responsible for their own things is an important part of our preparation for their senior school life and if they are organised at the beginning of term this is a good start.
