### BACKGROUND TO THE SCHOOL

Founded in 1949 in Winchester, Prince's Mead is a co-educational day preparatory school for children aged 3 to 11. These characteristics allow it to stand out from other independent schools in the area and place it in a unique position to enable children to move on to a wide variety of secondary schools and particularly the very good 11+ day schools in Hampshire and beyond. Senior school destinations are never prescriptive, however, and the school works closely with parents to prepare children for the full range of possible choices.

Prince's Mead is located in a glorious setting, occupying Worthy Park House; a large former Georgian residence dating back to 1820. With wonderful views across the Itchen Valley, the twelve acres of grounds complement the house and provide a perfect setting for delivering education as well as an impressive sport offering and other co-curricular activities. Enhancements have included a multipurpose sports hall, music practice rooms and the latest development of four new classrooms and a modern kitchen and dining hall (completed in 2019). This latter work has also allowed for the redevelopment of the Coach House in order to provide an Early Years facility, which is proving highly popular. Focusing on our teaching provision we are pleased to be rolling out the Pre-Senior Baccalaureate (PSB) model and our exciting investment in a Virtual Learning Platform and personal devices.

Prince's Mead is very strong academically and offers a fantastic breadth in its curriculum. There are dedicated classrooms for Science, ICT, DT and Art. Music is important both in the classroom and through peripatetic music teachers. The school is known for its outdoor education and has its own Forest School in Gray's Wood. Children experience several day trips throughout the year and by the end of their time here will have climbed two mountain peaks in the UK, making Prince's Mead the only prep school in the country to climb two mountains! The school is the only independent school in the area to operate a free minibus service in the mornings and afternoons. The red minibuses have become iconic in the local community to assist with travel. The school currently has 290 children on roll and there are exciting plans to develop the buildings and facilities further.



The school met all standards of regulatory compliance when it was inspected by the Independent Schools Inspectorate (ISI) in May 2023 and was found to be excellent in all areas of the Integrated Inspection.

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# **GENERAL OVERVIEW**

As our Sports Graduate/Teaching Assistant, you will be responsible for supporting the PE department team for our Early Years to Year 2 and taking Prep School (Year 3-6) games, helping to ensure the smooth running of curricular and extra-curricular sports and attending sports fixtures. The major games of the school are Football, Netball, Rugby, Hockey and Cricket. You will also contribute to the maintenance and development of the profile of the PE department both in school and in the wider community. In the mornings, the role will extend to being a Teaching Assistant, supporting our Prep School children in English and Maths.

A teaching qualification will not be required. However, the candidate will need to have passed Maths and English at GCSE level and be confident and keen to support children in these subjects.



### JOB DESCRIPTION

# Responsibilities and Duties:

The duties outlined in this job description may be modified by the Headmaster, with your agreement, to reflect or anticipate changes in the job. The core working hours will be from 8.00am – 4pm, Monday to Friday, with some flexibility for matches (late returns) and will include one after-school club a week (4.10pm to 5.10pm).



# Assist in the delivery of coaching of PE/games lessons and the sporting co-curricular programme:

- Assist in the delivery of core PE, games, and swimming lessons.
- Assist in department administration as directed by the Director of Sport.
- Coaching, scoring, refereeing or umpiring fixtures.
- In conjunction with qualified staff, assist and lead small groups with the teaching of Sport by delivering high quality, up-to-date and challenging sessions across all age groups under the supervision of the PE department.
- To help with home or away team fixtures by coaching and managing teams.
- To be responsible for team sheets, match reports and other team-based administration, if necessary.
- Participate in one after-school club per week (does not need to be sports based).
- Working with individual children, or small groups, as appropriate.

# To help all children learn as effectively as possible by, for example:

- Supporting Prep children in English and Maths.
- Clarifying and explaining instructions.
- Ensuring the child is able to use the equipment and materials provided.
- Motivating and encouraging the children as required.
- Assisting in weaker areas (e.g. language, behaviour, reading, spelling,

handwriting/presentation, comprehension etc.).

• Helping pupils to concentrate on and finish work set.

• Supporting other areas of the school, either academically or otherwise.



- Undertake break and supervisory duties as designated by the Deputy Head.
- Accompanying staff and pupils on school visits and trips, as required.
- Be aware pf all necessary health and safety procedures, such as fire evacuation/asthma/EpiPen policies etc.
- Be aware of confidential issues linked to home/pupil/teacher/school and keep confidences appropriately.
- Attend staff meetings, parent meetings and other meetings, within or outside normal school hours, according to the Meetings Schedule and as required by the Senior Leadership Team.
- Attend all Staff training, INSET and Study Days, according to Term Dates for Staff and the Meetings Schedule.



## PERSONAL SPECIFICATION

- Good Honours degree preferably in a sport specific or sport related course.
- Someone who is confident and keen to assist children in English and Maths (GCSE passes in both).
- Experience in teaching/coaching children in a variety of sports and having a specialism in at least one.
- Enthusiastic and committed to promoting a 'sport for all' ethos as well as a high level of sporting performance.
- High degree of personal motivation, initiative, energy, creativity and drive.
- Confidence to officiate in either of the following major games would be desirable. Football/Netball/Rugby/Hockey/Cricket.
- Holds an umpiring/refereeing qualification or working towards this would be desirable.
- Able to foster good working relationships with all members of the School community (staff, pupils, parents/carers and representatives of other schools) either in person or on the phone.



- Be able to work on your own initiative to a high standard. To be able to prioritise when there are conflicting demands in order to meet deadlines.
- Friendly and approachable with a can-do mind-set. Strong communication skills.
- High degree of personal motivation, initiative, energy, creativity and drive.
- Self-motivated and versatile, showing an ability to work on own initiative, plan, prioritise, coordinate and lead, taking ownership of a task and seeing it through to completion.
- Commitment to promote and safeguard the welfare of children and young people.

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#### REMUNERATION

Salary is dependent upon qualifications and experience but will be set against the School's Teaching Assistant Pay Scale. There are further benefits including: pension, free lunch and tea and onsite parking.



# **APPLICATION PROCESS**
